A pond



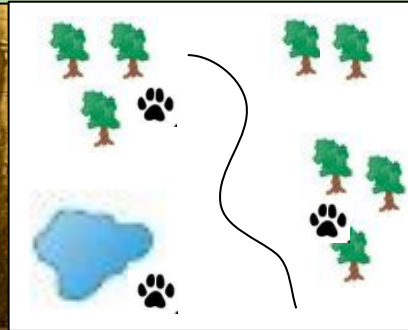
A pond is a small habitat with water.
